## Market Review & Outlook

- **Malaysia Market Review.** The FBM KLCI (-0.1%) concluded the week with a softer note as investors continue to stayed on the sideline ahead of the release of US key inflation indicator. The lower liners also retreated, while the Energy sector (+0.8%) outperformed among its sectoral peers.
- **Global Markets Review.** US stock markets rebounded following the release of Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) that came in line with market expectations, raising prospect on September interest rate cut. European and Asia stock markets ended mostly higher buoyed by optimism stemming from the US market.
- Market Outlook. Recent US PCE data highlights easing consumer spending, which boosted confidence on potential cooldown in inflation rate. Back home, the FBM KLCI is likely to trend upwards driven by optimistic sentiment observed in the US market. Economic wise, investors will be keeping an eye onto Malaysia's PPI to be release today. Moving forward, we advocate directing attention towards gold-related stocks, following the strength in rising gold prices which hovered above US\$2,300/oz. On the other hand, oil & gas stocks might come under pressure with weakness in Brent oil prices as China oil import in June took a dive. This, coupled with surprise rate cuts in China, has raised concerns that Beijing is struggling to revive the world's second-largest economy.

- Kumpulan Kitacon Bhd's wholly owned subsidiary company, Kitacon Sdn Bhd has secured a RM54.5mil construction contract from Rawang Lakes Sdn Bhd.
- AirAsia X Bhd will be acquiring Capital A Bhd's aviation business directly, and not via a new company (NewCo) under an internal reorganisation proposed previously, to expedite the takeover.
- Hibiscus Petroleum Bhd has been awarded a 65% participating interest and operatorship in a production sharing contract by Petroliam Nasional Bhd (Petronas).
- Separately, Petronas awarded Ping Petroleum Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary of Dagang NeXchange and Duta Marine Sdn Bhd a small field asset (SFA) cluster PSC for the Bubu, Bunga Tasbih and Enau fields.
- **ViTrox Corp Bhd**'s co-founders are partnering with private equity firm Southern Capital Group to create a venture capital fund, aims to support local tech startups and nurture a robust tech ecosystem in Malaysia.
- Ekovest Bhd has agreed to a further extension of time to discuss a merger between its wholly owned subsidiary Ekovest Construction Sdn Bhd (ECSB) and Knusford Bhd.
- Alam Maritim Resources Bhd has announced its regularisation plan, which includes a share capital reduction of RM440 million, 10-to-one share consolidation, an issuance of renounceable rights shares with warrants and a scheme of arrangement with its creditors.
- Datasonic Group Bhd has secured a RM30 million contract to supply smart cards to Perum Percetakan Negara Republik Indonesia (PNRI), a unit of the Indonesian Ministry of State-Owned Enterprises.
- **Kumpulan Kitacon Bhd** has secured a RM54.5 million contract to undertake the construction of 186 terrace houses in Rawang, Selangor.
- **DXN Holdings Bhd**'s net profit for the first quarter ended May 31, 2024 rose 10.26% to RM85.56 million or earnings per share of 1.72 sen, compared with RM77.60 million or 1.60 sen per share over the same period last year.
- Homeritz Corp Bhd's net profit for the third quarter ended May 31, 2024 surged 46.37% to RM9.09 million or earnings per share of 1.96 sen, from RM6.21 million or 1.34 sen per share a year earlier, thanks to higher sales volume and the stronger US dollar.
